3. Procurement may be consolidated into appropriate lots, rate contracts, schemes or work packages; requirements shall not be split to avoid competition.
4. Engineering M&R packages shall proceed after administrative approval, technical sanction, approved estimates/specifications and availability of funds.
5. Establishment, pension, utilities, refunds, statutory contributions, fund transfers and liabilities are not included because they are not planned procurement packages in this schedule.
