**(OPEN FRAMEWORK AGREEMENT — PROCUREMENT OF NON-CONSULTANCY SERVICES)**

Prequalification of Firms / Workshops / Vendors for Repair & Maintenance Works

1. The Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs invites applications for prequalification from eligible and qualified firms / workshops / vendors for the establishment of an Open Framework Agreement for Repair & Maintenance Works (Non-Consultancy Services), to be executed through subsequent Call-Off Contract(s) during the Framework Agreement period.
2. Applicants may apply for prequalification in one or more of the following categories, according to their fields of competence; a firm shall be evaluated and prequalified separately for each category applied for:
  - (i) Repair & Maintenance of Vehicles / Transport
  - (ii) Repair & Maintenance of Machinery & Equipment
  - (iii) Repair & Maintenance of Furniture & Fixtures
  - (iv) Repair & Maintenance of Computer Hardware / (v) Software & (vi) I.T. Equipment
3. Following prequalification, a Framework Agreement shall be signed with the successful applicant(s) for a period of twelve (12) months. Only the prequalified applicants shall be entitled to participate in the subsequent procurement proceedings. Repair and maintenance jobs shall thereafter be assigned to the prequalified firm(s) in accordance with the Public Procurement Rules, 2004.
4. Prequalification is open to all national applicants who fulfil the eligibility requirements specified in the Prequalification Documents. A complete set of documents may be accessed, and applications submitted, only through EPADS v2.0; manual submissions shall not be entertained. Applications must be submitted within fifteen (15) days from the date of publication of this notice and will be opened on the same day. Applications received after the deadline shall not be entertained.
5. Vendors not yet registered on EPADS v2.0 may complete registration at <https://vendors.epads.gov.pk/>. Guidance on registration and submission is available on the portal.
6. In terms of Rule 48 of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004, the Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) has been notified for the subject procurement; the notification is available on the Procuring Agency's website and on the PPRA website.
