The Directorate General of Special Education (DGSE), M/o FE&PT Islamabad, invites applications for prequalification from well-reputed, experienced and financially sound firms, suppliers, contractors and service providers, duly registered with the SECP / Registrar of Firms / PEC (as applicable) and with the Income Tax and Sales Tax authorities for the following:

A separate bid security of Rs. 500,000/- (Rupees Five Hundred Thousand only) shall be furnished for each lot applied for, in the form of a Bank Draft / Pay Order / CDR drawn in favour of the Director (Admin), DGSE, Islamabad. The original instrument shall reach the office of the undersigned on or before the closing date and time. Applications received without original bid security shall not be entertained.
