Tender Notice No. 04 for the financial year 2026-27

PROCUREMENT OF ENGINE OIL FOR DIESEL, PETROL VEHICLES & MOTORCYCLES

1. Islamabad Police intends to procure quality Engine Oil for Diesel, Petrol Vehicles and Motorcycles during Financial Year 2026-27.
2. Sealed electronic bids are required from eligible bidders for the purchase of goods listed in the bidding documents available on the Islamabad Capital Territory Police, EPADS Version 2.0.
3. All interested firms/companies, holding valid and active NTN and Sales Tax Registration Number (STRN), are invited to participate in the bidding process through the e-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) V-2.0 of the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA).
4. Only registered entities/firms who are regular in paying Sales Tax and Income Tax can participate in the tender. I pay and am included in the Active Tax Payers List of FBR. The tender should be accompanied by a certified copy of the firm's registration, General Sales Tax Registration, certified copy of National Tax Number and bank account details of the firm. Vendor number AGPR, if in Islamabad, should be clearly mentioned.
5. Single Stage Two Envelope method will be adopted for this procurement, in which Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) will be done. This process will be in accordance with the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 and the rules, regulations, guidelines and instructions issued by the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) from time to time.
6. Each bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security of the prescribed value mentioned in the Bid Security section of the bidding documents, which can be in the form of Pay Order, Call Deposit Receipt (CDR), Bank Guarantee or Demand Draft will be acceptable. Bid Securing Declaration may also be submitted as per the prescribed procedure, where permitted in the bidding documents.
7. The electronic bidding documents, which include detailed terms and conditions, technical specifications, essential requirements and other information, are available on the e-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) version 2.0.
8. Registration on EPADS version 2.0 is mandatory for all interested bidders to participate in the bidding process.
9. Electronic bids prepared as per the instructions given in the bidding documents should be submitted only through EPADS version 2.0 up to 11:00 AM on **Monday, 27 July 2026**. Bids will be opened on the same day at 11:30 AM through EPADS. Manually submitted bids will not be accepted under any circumstances. -
- 10 The department may increase or decrease the quantity of required items keeping in view the requirement.
