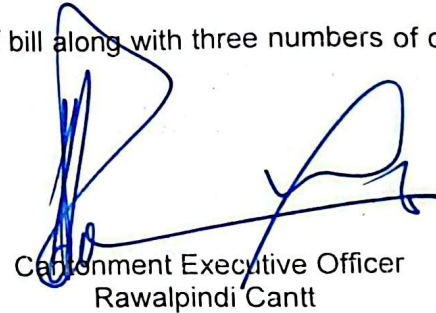

NOTICE INVITING E-BIDDING SINGLE STAGE ONE ENVELOP
THROUGH E-PADS

Rawalpindi Cantonment Board (RCB), being the Procuring Agency, invites electronic bids from reputable and experienced firms/workshops registered with the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) possessing valid NTN and Sales Tax Registration (Active Taxpayer Status) for the following procurement for repair / maintenance of RCB Vehicles through EPADS Version 2.0 in accordance with the Public Procurement Rules, 2004.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

i. Availability of Documents:

Bidding documents shall be available **only on PPRA and EPADS V2.0 portals**. No hard copies shall be issued. Only firms registered on EPADS as vendors shall be eligible to participate.

ii. Submission & Opening of Bids:

E-bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions contained in the bidding documents, must be submitted **electronically through EPADS V2.0** on or before:

03 August, 2026 at 1:00 PM

The bids will be opened on the same day at:

03 August, 2026 at 1:30 PM

iii. Manual submission of bids shall not be entertained. Vendors not registered on EPADS V2.0 may register at: <https://vendors.epads.gov.pk/>

iv. Grievance Redressal:

In accordance with **Rule 48 of PPRA Rules, 2004**, a **Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC)** has been constituted. The notification is available on the procuring agency's website and EPADS portal.

v. Procurement Method:

Procurement shall be carried out through **Open Competitive Bidding** under **Single Stage – One Envelope Procedure** PPRA rule 36(a) adopting the **Least Cost Based Selection (LCBS)** technique in line with PPRA Rules, 2004.

vi. **Earnest Money:**

Bidders shall submit **2% of the estimated cost** in the shape of **Call Deposit Receipt (CDR)** issued by any scheduled bank in favour of the **Cantonment Executive Officer, Rawalpindi Cantonment Board**.

- i. A scanned copy shall be uploaded with the e-bid.
- ii. The original CDR must be submitted **prior to opening of bids**.

vii. **Eligibility Criteria**

The bidding firms/workshops shall:

- i. Be registered with FBR and possess valid NTN and active Sales Tax Registration.
- ii. Have relevant experience in repair and maintenance of vehicles.
- iii. Not be blacklisted or debarred by any Government, Semi-Government or Autonomous Organization.
- iv. Fulfil all requirements specified in the bidding documents.

viii. **Award of Contract:**

Issuance of work order shall be subject to the approval of the **Competent Authority**.

ix. **Eligibility:**

Firms/contractors **blacklisted by any Government/Semi-Government organization** shall not be eligible to participate.

x. **Additional Terms:**

Before submitting the bid, every intending bidder shall mandatorily visit the Rawalpindi Cantonment Board (RCB) Workshop during office hours to inspect the vehicles and assess their mechanical condition, the extent of repairs required, and the overall scope of work. Submission of a bid shall be deemed to constitute confirmation that the bidder has thoroughly inspected the vehicles and is fully satisfied regarding the nature and quantity of the repair and maintenance works required. No claim for additional payment or revision of quoted rates on the ground of inadequate inspection or lack of knowledge of the condition of the vehicles shall be entertained after submission of the bid.

The successful bidder shall execute all repair and maintenance works, including the supply and installation of genuine spare parts, in accordance with the approved Work Order and the manufacturer's specifications. All repair works shall be carried out to the complete satisfaction of the Workshop Incharge, Rawalpindi Cantonment Board. Any repair work found to be defective, incomplete, or not conforming to the required standards during inspection shall be rectified or re-executed by the Contractor at his own cost without any additional financial liability on the Procuring Agency. The repaired vehicle

shall not be considered complete or accepted until it has been inspected, tested and certified as satisfactory by the Workshop Incharge.

Detailed terms and conditions may be seen in the office of the Rawalpindi Cantonment Board during working hours on any working day.

xi. **Right of Rejection:**

The Procuring Agency reserves the right to **accept or reject any or all bids** prior to acceptance in accordance with **Rule 33(1) of PPRA Rules, 2004**, without assigning any reason.
