

Government employees stage sit-in, demand restoration of privileges

that people were committing suicide due to ever-increasing inflation but the government was watching the whole drama while turning the blind eye to their plight, the angry protesters said.

Secretary KTU Abdul Rauf General while addressing said that the Punjab government has taken away the legal privileges of the employees and forced them to protest.

APCA leader Chaudhry Mubashir said that we are not asking for blue passports, palaces, luxury cars or a 600 percent increase in salaries but want the restoration of our snatched privileges.

Basharat Qadri, President PTU, said that the Punjab government did not give last year's disparity reduction allowance. This year too, only seven percent salary raise was given to the
