PROCUREMENT OF NON-CONSULTANCY SERVICES

1. The **Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) (Federal Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA))** has reserved Funds for the procurement planned for FY **2026-27**. The **Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) (Federal Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA))** intends to apply part of the proceeds of this Fund to cover eligible payments under the contract for the "**Procurement of Security Services**" with the reference of "**P53225**"
2. The **Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) (Federal Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA))** invites Bids through **EPADS v2.0** from eligible Bidders registered on **EPADS v2.0** for provision of Non-Consultancy Services.
3. **Single Stage-One Envelope** Procedure of Principal Method of Procurement (i.e. Open Competitive Bidding) will be used by adopting **Least Cost Based Selection (LCBS)** Technique for the subject procurement, in line with the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 and any Regulations, and Instructions issued by the Authority (from time to time).
4. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security described in Bid Security Section in Bidding Document in the form of **Pay Order, Banker's Cheque, Call at Deposit, Demand Draft** or Bid Securing Declaration on the prescribed format described.
5. E-Bidding documents, containing detailed terms & conditions, specifications and requirements etc. are available on **e-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS)** at **<https://epads.gov.pk/opportunities/federal/procurements/53225>**.
6. The e-bids, prepared in accordance with the instructions in the e-Bidding documents, must be submitted through **EPADS v2.0** on or before **Monday, July 20, 2026 11:00 AM**. E-bids will be opened on the same day at **Monday, July 20, 2026 11:30 AM**. Manual submission of Bids shall not be
