Speaking on the occasion, Sikandar Shehzad Khan said the ANP would not accept the imposition of any tax or customs law in Malakand Division, arguing that the region enjoys a special constitutional and historical status. He said that agreements and written memoranda signed at the time of the merger of the former princely State of Swat into Pakistan had recognised the area's special status, making any taxation unconstitutional and against the fundamental rights of its residents.

He announced that the ANP had convened an All Parties Conference (APC) to discuss the proposed taxation, public concerns, and formulate a joint strategy against the move. Representatives of political parties and other stakeholders would participate in the conference to deliberate on the issue, he added.
