PROCUREMENT OF GOODS

1. The **Collectorate of Customs Enforcement (Pakistan Customs)** has sufficient / has received / intends to apply for funds from **Non-ADP** and intends to apply part of such funds toward payments under the Framework Agreement for **Framework agreement for Purchase of Other / miscellaneous items** having reference number **FFW10057**.
 2. The **Collectorate of Customs Enforcement (Pakistan Customs)** intends to prequalify suppliers for subsequent Invitation to Bid(s) and to sign a Closed Framework Agreement with the successful bidder(s) following completion of the bidding process.
 3. The objective of the intended Closed Framework Agreement is the on-demand supply of **Framework agreement for Purchase of Other / miscellaneous items** through subsequent Call-Off Contract(s) during the Framework Agreement period. The purpose of this Prequalification Notice is to provide basic information to enable potential applicants to decide whether to respond to this Prequalification Notice.
 4. Only the prequalified applicants shall be entitled to participate in the subsequent procurement proceedings. It is expected that Invitations to Bid will be issued to the Prequalified Applicants in **Friday, September 25, 2026**. The Closed Framework Agreement is expected to be signed with the successful bidder(s) in **Thursday, October 22, 2026** for a period of **9 Months**.
 5. The Prequalification process is open to all **National** Applicants subject to fulfilling the eligibility requirements specified in the Prequalification Documents. Interested Applicants may obtain further information from **Collectorate of Customs Enforcement (Pakistan Customs)** through **EPADS v2.0** during office hours.  6. The application, prepared in accordance with the instructions contained in the Prequalification Documents, must be submitted through **EPADS v2.0** on or before **Monday, October 12, 2026 05:00 PM**. Applications will be opened electronically through **EPADS v2.0** on the same day at **Monday, October 12, 2026 05:30 PM**. Manual submission of applications shall not be entertained.
 7. Vendors who have not yet registered on **EPADS v2.0** may complete their registration at <https://vendors.epads.gov.pk/>. Guidance regarding registration and bid submission is available on the portal.
