Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation is an autonomous corporation under the administrative control of Ministry of Energy (Petroleum Division), Government of Pakistan invites electronic bids from the interested parties/contractor/suppliers registered with Sales Tax/Income Tax Departments, and who are on active taxpayers list of the Federal Board of Revenue for supply of PPE items at PMDC Head Office, Islamabad and PMDC Branch Office, Quetta.

The firms shall submit proposals in accordance with the instructions contained in the RFP document alongwith bid money of Rs. 500,000/- in the shape of demand draft/pay order in the name of Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation on account of bidder, electronically through EPADS on or before 03rd March 2026 at 11:00 AM. The technical proposal opening will take place on the same date at 11:30 AM on EPAD, at PMDC Head Office, Islamabad with the participation of representatives from interested firms (if interested), whereas the financial proposal of only qualified firms will be opened later. General Terms and Conditions:

1. Electronic Bid must be submitted (Single Stage – Two Envelope Method) on EPADS on or before **03rd March, 2026 at 11:00 AM**, Technical proposals will be opened at PMDC Head Office, Islamabad on the same day at **11:30 AM** in the presence of bidder or their authorized representative. Financial proposals of firms passing the minimum threshold of 65% weightage will be opened later and financial proposals of unsuccessful firms will remain unopened.
2. The criteria adopted by PMDC for the award of this assignment is the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) method, in accordance with the PPRA Rules.
3. Bid Money of **Rs. 500,000 /-** in the form of pay order/demand draft made in the name of Pakistan Mineral Development Corporation on account of bidder from any scheduled bank shall accompany the bid/tender. Tender with less or without bid money (in the form of pay order/demand draft) or pay order/demand draft without the name of bidder shall not be considered.
4. Amount of bid money and security money will not be accepted through cheques. Amount already available with PMDC on behalf of the tenderer for any other purpose will not be substituted for the purpose of bid money/security money/performance guarantee against this tender.
5. Financial proposal/quoted rates should be in PRK and must be inclusive of all taxes.
6. Successful tender will be required to deposit security performance money equal to 10% of the total contract value. Bid money already deposited will be converted into security deposit while balance amount shall have to be deposited to maintain the security deposit @ 10% of the total order value which will be refunded after completion of warranty period/one year.
7. Bidder must have valid distribution/authority letter from manufacturer/OEM along after sales/repair services in Pakistan. Copy of evidence to be shared along bid.
8. Bids should remain valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of financial tenders.
9. PMDC reserves the right to order partial or complete items.
10. Country of origin and make of each part should be mentioned clearly.
11. Tenders with over-writing, cutting or conditional or by fax or email shall not be accepted.
12. In case, order is placed within the validity period, escalation in prices will not be considered and any bidder asking for increase in the prices after the order has been placed within the validity period will render himself liable for blacklisting and forfeiting/confiscation of his performance guarantee and bid money.
13. The authorized representative of the bidder/bidding firm will only be allowed to sit in the tender opening on presentation of authority letter from the bidder/bidding firm issued in favor of representative to participate in the specific tender.



14. The Firm/Contractor should have 03 years' experience in relevant supply (PPE items of similar nature) to Govt. departments or other organizations/companies. Proof of experience/work order should be attached along with bid.
15. Firm/Contractor or any its subsidiary firms or of its directors/owners or any their relatives' parents, children, brother, sister) should not be under litigation with PMDC in any local or foreign court law.
16. Firm/Contractor or any of its subsidiary firms or of its directors/owners or any their relatives' parents, children, brother, sister) should not have any ongoing, under resolved business dispute with PMDC, PMDC shall be sole judge of fulfillment of this requirement.
17. In case of any dispute regarding this purchase order, the same will be resolved between the relevant parties through negotiations. If negotiations fail, then matter will be referred to the Arbitrator. The MD, PMDC will act as sole Arbitrator as per Arbitration Act, 1940. Decision/award of Arbitrator will be final and binding on both parties.
18. In case of non-completion of assignment as per agreed timelines after signing of agreement, firm will be liable to be blacklisted and PMDC reserves the right to take legal action in court of law including the reimbursement of any paid advances and cost incurred.
19. Payment will be made within 30 days of job completion. All applicable taxes, as per prevailing rates at the time of payment, will be deducted accordingly.
20. Tenders are advised to read the terms and conditions of Tender Enquiry along with the specification/ TORs carefully before offering their bids/offers.
21. The tenderer/supplier will be blacklisted who is found to the tender process by making coercive practices, collusive practices, corrupt practices, fraudulent practices & obstructive practices.

26. **WARRANTY:** Manufacturer Standard Warranty (Minimum one year) from the date of delivery.

Note: Technical Qualification status shall be decided based on overall score obtained by the applicant(s). The applicant must secure at least **65 % score** to proceed with the opening of financial proposal. Percentage weight of technical proposal will be 80 % and financial proposal will be 20 %.

FINAL EVALUATION CRITERIA

Technically qualified/successful Bidders(s) shall be called for opening of the Financial Proposal(s). The technically Eligible/Successful Bidders(s) or their authorized representatives shall be allowed to take part in the Financial Proposal(s) opening if they desire.



The formula for determining the financial scores is as follows:

Formula: $FS = 100 \times FM / F$

Where FS is the Financial Score; FM is the Lowest Price and F is the Price of the Proposal under consideration.

The weights given to the Technical (T) and Financial Proposals (F) are:

T = 0.80 and F = 0.20

For example: $T = 80 \times 80\% = 64$
 $FS = 100 \times 5M + 8M = 62.5 \times 20\% = 12.50$
Total Score: $T + FS = 64 + 12.50 = 76.50$

Applicants(s) with the highest total score will be considered further for Contract.
