PROPOSAL FOR PREQUALIFICATION

Invitation for Prequalification of Firms Through
Open Framework Agreement(s)
NHMP, N-5, Central-II, Multan

1. The Sector N-5 (C-II), Multan has sufficient funds under the head of **Repair of Transport** intends to prequalify suppliers for Goods/Services of above mentioned Head from regular budget for the Financial Year 2025-26 to 2027-28 (03 years) at Sector N-5 Central-II, Multan. Supply of Goods/Services shall be delivered at office of The DSP, LHQs, N-5 Central-II, Multan. Invites to submit Bid(s), and sign the open framework agreement(s) with the selected bidder(s) subsequent to bidding process in case of open Framework Agreement(s). The Bids will be received only from those firms who are registered with NTN, GST, PST, Active tax payer list and PPRA for E-procurement on E-PADS for tendering through their Email address which was provided by them to PPRA at the time of their registration.
2. Prequalification process is open for all national Applicants subject to fulfilling the eligibility requirements mentioned in the respective Prequalification Documents. Interested Applicants may obtain further information from office of the DSP, LHQs, N-5 Central-II, Multan during office hours.
3. The objective of the intended open framework agreement(s) is the on-demand supply of Goods/Services regarding repair of Official Vehicles of N-5 Central-II, Multan through subsequent Call-off Contract(s) with successful bidders, and the purpose of this Prequalification Notice is to provide the very basic information to enable the potential applicants to decide whether or not to respond to this Prequalification Notice.
4. Applications for Prequalification must be submitted in hard form in clearly marked envelopes and delivered to the address mentioned above latest by 11:30 AM on 02-04-2026. Only those Bids will be entertained which are submitted in hard form along with bid security in the form of pay order and CDRs (bank cheque will not be accepted). Late Applications will be rejected.
5. Initially open framework agreements will be entered in to with prequalified firms or bidders for the period of open framework as mentioned in prequalification documents and a mini competition among the prequalified bidders shall be carried out for each procurement / repair for the Vehicles / budget head and the lowest bidder shall be evaluated item wise. Bid security CDRs of Rs. **50,000/-** of successfully pre-qualified firms shall be considered as performance Security and retained till the expiry of open frame work agreement.
