Invitation to Proposal through E-Procurement (e-PADS)

BISP hereby invites e-proposals for "Third-Party Validation of Prime Minister's Ramzan Relief Package (PMRRP), 2026" from the eligible Consultants/Firms mandated by GoP to execute such services and who are registered with PPRA for E-Procurement on "e-Pak Acquisition and Disposal system (e-PADS)", having Income & Sales Tax registration and are on Active Taxpayers List (ATL) of FBR. For using the e-PADS, unregistered bidders may first register on website <https://eprocure.gov.pk/#/supplier/registration>; in case of any technical difficulty in registration or using e-PADS, the prospective firms may contact PPRA's technical team.

2. The Firm will be selected under Least Cost Selection (LCS) Procedure pursuant Procurement of Consultancy Services Regulations, 2010 (using Single Stage Two Envelope procedure) read with relevant provisions of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 (as amended from time to time) and procedures described in the RFP document and E-Pak-Procurement Regulations, 2023.

3. The complete set of RFP containing description and detailed terms & conditions is available on the websites of PPRA (www.ppra.org.pk), BISP (www.bisp.gov.pk) and e-PADS (www.eprocure.gov.pk) and can be downloaded free of cost.

4. All e-Proposals must be submitted through e-PADS. Sealed bids (as prescribed in Bid Data Sheet of the Bidding Document) of the submitted e-PADS Tender Prints, shall be received in accordance with the provisions of Rule 36(b) of Public Procurement Rules, 2004, read with e-PADS Regulations and the terms and conditions defined in the document. Proposal should reach Benazir Income Support Programme, F-Block, Pak. Secretariat, Islamabad on/or before **3rd April, 2026 at 1400 hours**. All the bidders are required to mandatorily sign the Proposal Securing Declaration form. The received e-Proposals will be opened by the designated Procurement Evaluation Committee on the same date at **1430 hours** in the presence of the bidders or their authorized representatives, who may choose to be present. A pre-proposal conference will also be held at the afore-mentioned address dated **25th March, 2026 at 1100 hours**.

5. Notification of GRC constituted in terms of Rule-48 of PP Rules, 2004 is provided on the websites of BISP, PPRA and e-PADS, further details are available in the Document - RFP.

6. In case opening date(s) is declared as a Public Holiday by the Government, the next working date shall be deemed to be the date for submission and opening of tender(s) at the same time and place. BISP may reject all bids/proposals at any time prior to the acceptance of a bid by invoking rule 33 of Public Procurement Rule (PPR), 2004.
