

PROCUREMENT NOTICE PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES

1. The Collectorate of Custom Enforcement, Gadani (Pakistan Customs) has reserved funds for procurement planned for FY 2025-26. The Collectorate intends to apply part of the proceeds of this fund to cover eligible payments under the contract for consultancy services titled:

“Hiring of Individual Engineering Consultant for Design, Cost Estimation, Tender Documentation, Construction Supervision and Contract Administration of Repair, Renovation and Upgradation Works at Collectorate of Customs (Enforcement), Gadani.”

2. The Collectorate invites Requests for Proposals (RFP) through EPADS v2.0 from eligible bidders registered on EPADS v2.0 for provision of consultancy services.

3. The procurement will be conducted under Single Stage – Two Envelope Procedure using Open Competitive Bidding, adopting Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS), in accordance with Public Procurement Rules, 2004 and applicable regulations.

4. All proposals must be accompanied by Bid Security as specified in the bidding documents, in the form of Pay Order, Banker’s Cheque, Call Deposit, Bank Guarantee, or Bid Securing Declaration.
