



# PRE-QUALIFICATION NOTICE

**Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response System (IDSRS) Project**, National Institute of Health (NIH), Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination, Islamabad intends to pre-qualify firms/ vendors registered with Sales Tax/ Income Tax, PEC and on Active Taxpayer List (ATL) of FBR having their own offices/ stock/ manpower/ workshop/ expertise for following procurements of works and services required during Fiscal Year 2025-26 (extendable) under rule 15 & 16(a), as amended from time to time. Details are as under: -

1.	Pre-Qualification of Firms/Vendors for the following services:  1. Upgradation and Re-evaluation of Laboratories at Gilgit-Baltistan (Chilas, Skardu & Gilgit), on an as-and-when-required Basis, During FY 2025-26 (Extendable). In accordance with Rule 15 & 16(a) of the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 (as amended from time to time).

2. Pre-Qualification bids would be collected and opened as-per the following schedule:

Date of collection of Bidding Documents (sealed tender bids)	Bidding documents shall be collected through e-Pak Acquisition & Disposal System (EPADS). All prospective bidders shall apply for pre-qualification 2025-26 through EPADS.
Date, Time & Place of Publicly opening of Bids.	20-04-2026 at 12:30 P.M. in National Institute of Health (NIH), Park Road, Chak Shahzad, Islamabad.

3. The Procuring Agency intends to pre-qualify technically and financially capable firms under Rules 15 and 16 of the PPSA Rules, 2004, for extension in the roster/framework to be utilized through Call-Off / Mini-Competition under Rule-16(a), as and when required. Only those firms who are pre-qualified shall be eligible to participate in the secondary procurement process, and each assignment shall be awarded through a separate Call-Off / Mini-Competition among pre-qualified firms. The Bill of Quantities (BOQ) for each assignment shall be prepared and issued by the Procuring Agency at the Call-Off stage, and pre-qualified firms shall quote rates strictly against the issued BOQ. Rates / financial proposals shall only be sought at the Call-Off stage through Single Stage-Single Envelope procedure on EPADS. The period of the roster/framework shall be extendable up to three (3) years, subject to satisfactory performance and availability of assignments.

4. Interested eligible bidders are requested to register themselves on the EPADS (<https://eprocure.gov.pk/>) and submit their documents on EPADS. The interested eligible bidders may obtain a complete set of bidding documents containing list of items, specifications of required items and detailed terms & conditions, from the websites of PPSA and EPADS. The same shall also be obtained from Manager Procurement, IDSRS on payment of **Rs. 1,000/-** (cash) on any working days within the office hours (before the submission date of bid) on submission of written application on company letter head, duly supported by a copy of NTN and GST certificates.

5. The original hard copy of the uploaded bid must be submitted physically, on or before **11:00 A.M** by **20-04-2026** in **Procurement Manager, IDSRS room, NIH, Islamabad**. The bids will be opened on the same date at **12:30 P.M** in **Procurement Manager, IDSRS room, NIH, Islamabad** in terms of Rule 28 of PPSA, 2004. Non-submission or late submission shall render the application non-responsive.

6. In terms of Rule 48 of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) is constituted for subject procurement. Notification of the said GRC is provided on EPADS at [www.eprocure.gov.pk](http://www.eprocure.gov.pk).
