EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

1. National Grid Company of Pakistan Limited (NGC) (formerly National Transmission & Despatch Company – NTDC) is a State-Owned Enterprise responsible for the operation, maintenance and protection of Pakistan's high voltage electricity transmission network including 500 kV and 220 kV Grid Stations and transmission infrastructure across the country. NGC owns and operates a nationwide network of transmission installations and critical energy infrastructure that requires reliable, professional and well-trained security personnel.
2. NGC intends to engage reputable, licensed and experienced Private Security Companies under Open Framework Agreement for the outsourcing of security services at NGC grid stations, installations and offices located across Pakistan. NGC invites esteemed and experienced private security firms to express their interest in providing security services at NGC grid stations, installations and offices located across Pakistan to support NGC's security requirements.
3. NGC plans to establish a panel/pool of qualified security firms evaluated on the basis of relevant criteria as per the qualification requirements mentioned below. A Framework Agreement shall be executed with the shortlisted firms.

4. Scope of the Assignment

The selected firms, through separate call-off contracts, will provide comprehensive security services for NGC grid stations, colonies, offices and other installations / facilities across Pakistan including but not limited to:

- a. Deployment of armed and unarmed security guards for protection of NGC installations.
- b. Perimeter and internal patrolling of grid stations and related facilities.
- c. Access control and verification of personnel, visitors and vehicles entering installations.
- d. Security monitoring and observation of critical infrastructure and equipment.
- e. Maintenance of security registers, logbooks and incident records.
- f. Provision of point security for sensitive assets and installations.
- g. Provision of Quick Reaction Force (QRF) during emergency situations where required.
- h. Hang-around and standby security duties during operational contingencies.
- i. Coordination with local law enforcement agencies and NGC security authorities where required.
- j. Any other related security services to be assigned as per Open Framework Agreement / Work Order by NGC from time to time.

5. Eligibility Criteria

Interested firms must meet the following mandatory eligibility requirements:

- a. The security company should preferably be owned and/or managed by retired officers of Armed Forces or Law Enforcement Agencies, and should employ trained personnel preferably having military or police background.
- b. The firm must possess a valid All-Pakistan Security License issued by the Ministry of Interior, along with valid licenses from Provincial Home Departments.
- c. The firm must possess valid weapon licenses for weapons issued to deployed guards.
- d. The firm must have minimum three (03) years of experience in providing professional security services.
- e. The firm must be registered with SECP, FBR, EOBI, SESSI and APSSA (where applicable).
- f. The firm must provide group insurance coverage for deployed security personnel.
- g. The firm must have minimum 1,000 security guards deployed nationwide at the time of submission of EOI.
- h. The firm must maintain operational offices and footprint across Pakistan, including presence in major districts of all provinces.
- i. The firm must maintain a 24/7 supervision and monitoring system, including supervisors, checkers and a functional control room.
- j. The firm must possess positive net worth of last 03 years as depicted from Audited Financial Statements.

6. Eligibility Criteria

The submitted proposals will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

1	Length of experience of the security company (10 Marks for Mandatory Experience of 03 years and 01 marks for each subsequent year)	20
2	Projects executed with Power or Energy Sector / NGC / Government or large-scale private organizations (02 Marks for each client)	20
3	Available manpower strength (10 Marks for Mandatory 1000 sanctioned strength and 02 Marks for each additional 100 sanctioned strength)	20
4	Ratio of civilian and retired armed forces security personnel (10 Marks for 50:50 Ratio, 02 Marks each in additional 10% of Retired Armed Forces Guards)	20
5	Training arrangements and training certifications with approved Government agencies, APSSA and verification from special Branch (10 Marks for valid training arrangements and 02 marks for each certificate)	20
	Total Marks	100

A minimum of 60 score (overall) will be the qualifying score for shortlisting of a firm(s).

7. Mandatory Information and Documents

Interested security companies shall submit the following information / documents (attested copies) along with their EOI:

- a. Company profile including organizational structure and management details.
- b. SECP, FBR, EOBI, SESSI and APSSA Registration Certificates.
- c. Valid security licenses issued by Ministry of Interior and Provincial Home Departments.
- d. Details of weapons inventory and licenses.
- e. Details of manpower strength and deployment capability.
- f. List of major clients and projects completed in the last five years.
- g. Performance certificates and references from all the clients.
- h. Details of training facilities and training certifications of guards.
- i. Details of control room, monitoring systems and supervisory arrangements.
- j. Annual Financial Reports (Audited) for last Five Years
- k. Bank statement or certificate (not older than six months) showing annual credit turnover of at least Rs. 5 million.
- l. Three (03) years tax return certificates issued by FBR.
- m. Evidence of insurance coverage for security personnel.
- n. Any additional information demonstrating the firm's capability to perform the assignment.
- o. Original Affidavit on Rs.100 stamp paper duly attested by Oath Commissioner stating that:
 - i. No litigation is pending against the firm.
 - ii. The firm has not been blacklisted by any Government or private organization.
 - iii. The firm is not a tax defaulter.
 - iv. The firm has not been adjudged insolvent.
 - v. No decree of any court remains unsatisfied against the firm.
 - vi. The firm has not been convicted of any financial crime.
 - vii. The firm has not been delisted due to non-performance or violation of vendor conduct.
