BID EVALUATION REPORT

An advertisement of Tender Notice inviting sealed bids (single Stage-One Envelope) for supply of Uniform items was uploaded on the official website of the Public Procurements Regulatory Authority (PPRA), the official site of the Federal Board of Revenue, and ePADS, on 25.03.2025. The advertisement was also published in the two daily newspapers namely, 31.03.2026 (The News and Jang).

2. Sealed bids were received in office of the Chairman Procurement Committee and the same were also found uploaded on ePADS by 04.05.2026 till 12:30 pm. The sealed bids submitted by them were opened at 01:00 pm on the same day. The following firms participated in the said tender:-

3. The bids submitted by the above firms were opened by the committee, in presence of the representatives of the firms, for evaluation and assessment. The committee found that the bidder at Sr. No. of the above table i.e M/s. Abaseen General Order Supplier, has mistakenly uploaded the documents/bids for Stationery & Computer Stationery items etc. against the tender under evaluation. Hence, the said bidder cannot be considered in the instant case. Rest of the five (05) participating firms' documents and samples were examined in detail.

4. The evaluation sheet prepared in accordance with the requirement of the Department is placed at Annex-A. As per criteria, the bids/offers submitted by the above said bidders were evaluated in terms of Rule-35 of the PPRA Rules, 2004 read with Rule-36 of

the Rules *ibid* so as to determine the most advantageous bid in accordance with the public procurement law/rules. In addition, it was required that the bidders should annex the copies of following documents with their offers against the desired item:

- a) NTN/GST Registration
- b) Affidavit of non-blacklisting
- c) CDR amounting to Rs.240,000/-
- d) Quotations (item-wise)

5. Hence, the bidders quoting lowest prices for the items specified by the department were shortlisted. As the item-wise bids were solicited, therefore, the evaluation is made item-wise, accordingly.

6. In view of the above, the bidder-wise evaluation report is given as under:-

i. M/s. M/s. Durood Enterprises

M/s. Durood Enterprises has submitted all the documents. The firm is Sales Tax Registered. The CDR of Rs. 240,000/- No. 6640777 dated 02.05.2026 is attached. The items against which the said firm has submitted the lowest bids are annexed as **Annex-B**. It was observed that M/s. Durood Enterprises has not submitted the samples for Ceremonial Uniform & accessories thereof. Similarly, the quality of the samples provided by the bidder for Customs Field Uniform (CFU) was also examined and it was assessed that same was not up to the mark. Moreover, the bids submitted by the said firm could neither fetch the lowest price nor can be said to be “the most advantageous” one. Hence, the committee has recommended to reject the same.

ii. M/s. Janjua Tailors

M/s. Janjua Tailors has submitted all the documents. The firm is Sales Tax Registered. The CDR of Rs. 240,000/- No. 0074658460 dated 02.05.2026 is attached. The firm has quoted bids against all items, however, the same were found to be highest. However, M/s. Janjua Tailors was the only firm providing samples for the Ceremonial Uniforms. Hence, the bids submitted by the said firm were determined to be the most advantageous ones. Therefore, M/s. Janjua Tailors is recommended to be shortlisted for supply of Ceremonial Uniforms as and when required.

iii. M/s. Micro Tech

M/s. Micro Tech has submitted all the documents. The firm is Sales Tax Registered. The CDR of Rs. 500,000/- No. 15014842 dated 30.04.2026 is attached. The firm has submitted bids against Charcoal Grey category of uniforms only. However, it could

not fetch the lowest/appropriate price as compared to standard of quality of the samples provided. Hence, the Committee has rejected the bid submitted by M/s. Micro Tech.

iv. **M/s. Zeal Office Products**

M/s. Zeal Office Products has submitted all the documents. The firm is Sales Tax Registered. The CDR of Rs. 500,000/- No. 14670078 dated 16.04.2026 is attached. The firm has also submitted samples of all categories except for the Ceremonial Uniforms. The bids quoted by M/s. Zeal Office Products have been evaluated by the Committee as the lowest in price and appropriate as per quality of the samples submitted. Hence, the Committee has recommended to accept the bids subject to maintenance of quality and timeliness in supply of uniforms.

v. **M/s. Perfect Enterprises**

M/s. Perfect Enterprises has submitted all the documents. The firm is Sales Tax Registered. The PDC of Rs. 500,000/- No. 21419622 dated 05.05.2026 is attached. The firm has also submitted samples of all categories except for the Ceremonial Uniforms. The scrutiny of documents reveals that the firm has submitted PDC instead of CDR. Moreover, the date of PDC is mentioned as 05.05.2026, however, the closing date of the tender was 05.04.2026. The bids of the firm were evaluated by the committee and the samples examined. It was concluded that the firm could not qualify on any aspect of qualification as well as the lowest bid price. Hence, the Committee has recommended to reject the bids offered by M/s. Perfect Enterprises.

Conclusion

7. The bids submitted by the above firms were opened by the committee, in presence of the representatives of the firms, for evaluation and assessment. The committee found that four participating firms at S. No. i, ii, iv & vi were rejected on the grounds stated above. However, rest of the firms have been recommended for the supply of corresponding items stated in the above evaluation report to Collectorate of Customs (Airports), Islamabad.

7. Foregoing in view, the meeting of committee was held on 04.05.2026. The purchase committee recommended that, keeping in view, the requirements and available budget with Collectorate of Customs Airports, Islamabad, two firms namely: 1). M/s. Zeal Office Products, LG-261, Dean Trades Centre, Peshawar cantt. And 2) M/s. Janjua Tailors, Street # 03 Jinnah Street Quaid-E-Azam Colony, Rawalpindi are recommended for purchase Uniforms for

the officers/officials of the Collectorate of Customs (Airports), Islamabad during financial year 2025-26 by adhering to the conditions as laid down in the bidding documents / PPRA Rules, observing all legal and codal formalities.

8. This acceptance of bids, under Rule-38 of PPRA Rules, 2004, is subject to observance of rules, laws and maintenance of quality, quantity and timely supply of the items as and when required by the Collectorate.
