2. The Bidders Must Be Registered With NADRA Citizenship (CNIC) And Federal Board Of Revenue (FBR) For Income Tax And Sales Tax And Must Be On Active Taxpayer List.	—
3. E-Bidding Documents As Per Disposal Of Public Procurement Regulations – 2024, Containing Detailed Terms And Conditions And Requirements Etc Are Available On EPADS V2.0 At https://www.epads.gov.pk/ .	—
4. Manual Bids Shall Not Be Accepted. Electronic Bids Must Be Submitted Through EPADS V2.0 On Or Before 28 July 2026 At 1100 Hours And Will Be Opened Online On The Same Day At 1130 Hours.	—
5. Each Bidder Shall Submit The Prescribed Bid Security/Earnest Money Of Rs. 500,000 In Favor Of Works Dte NUST As Specified In The Tender Notice. Bids Submitted Without The Required Bid Security Shall Be Rejected.	—
6. The Bid Security Of The Successful Bidder Shall Be Retained And Adjusted Against The Final Payment, While Bid Securities Of Unsuccessful Bidders Shall Be Returned In Accordance With The Applicable Rules And Procedures.	—
