1. Pakistan Airports Authority (PAA) invites applications from reputed constructors/ joint ventures for Pre-qualification to undertake the project **“Up-gradation of Airside Infrastructure at Farooq Ahmad Khan Leghari (FAKL) International airport, D.G Khan”**.

2. Constructors/ firms/ joint ventures shall have following requirements:

a) Local constructor(s) applying individually shall have valid registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in Category C-A; and at least in Specialization Codes CE-01, CE-01 (iii), CE-10, EE-04, EE-05 and EE-06

b) Local constructors may form Joint Venture/ Consortium with local partner; each partner must have valid registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in **Category C-A**.

c) Foreign constructor(s) having registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in **FC-A Category** shall form joint venture/consortium with local Constructor(s) having registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in **Category C-A**.

The Joint Venture/ Consortium collectively shall have at least Specialization Codes CE-01, CE-01 (iii), CE-10, EE-04, EE-05, EE-06.

3. Pre-qualification documents as per regulations, containing detailed terms and conditions, and requirements, etc. can be downloaded from <https://eprocure.gov.pk> free of cost. Pre-qualification applications **must be submitted electronically through EPADS as well as in the hard format at the below-mentioned address**. The sealed pre-qualification documents(s) shall be opened on the same day at 1530 hours.

PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENT

1. INTRODUCTION

Pakistan Airports Authority (PAA) (hereinafter called the “Procuring Agency”) is undertaking the Works “**Up-gradation of Airside Infrastructure at FAKL International Airport, D.G Khan**”. For this purpose, Applications are invited from interested constructors/ Joint Ventures/ Consortiums.

2. SCOPE OF WORKS

The Contractor shall execute, complete, and remedy any defects in the Works in accordance with the Contract, the Specifications, the Drawings, and the instructions of the Engineer. The components of the Works shall consist of, but not limited to the following in respect of up-gradation, rehabilitation, strengthening, partial extension, and reconstruction of the airside infrastructure at FAKL International Airport, D. G. Khan:

- Scarification / Dismantling of existing pavement of Runway (18/36), Taxiway (Alpha) and shoulders as a Flexible pavement.
- Re-construction of existing Apron as Rigid pavement.
- All utilities and allied works.
- Removal of existing AFL lighting (if any)
- Installation of new LED based CAT-I AFL system for Runway (18/36)

3. INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS

3.1. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

- 3.1.1. Applications for pre-qualification (one original, one hard copy and one soft copy) must be submitted in sealed envelope and be clearly marked “Application for Qualification” for “Up-gradation of Airside Infrastructure at FAKL International Airport, D.G Khan”. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to accept or reject the late applications.
- 3.1.2. The name and mailing address of the Applicant shall be clearly marked left hand on the envelope.
- 3.1.3. The applications shall be prepared in the English language. Information in any other language shall be accompanied by its translation in English.
- 3.1.4. The Applicants must respond to all questions and provide complete information as advised in this document. Any false information provided or any lapses to provide essential information may result in disqualification of the Applicant.
- 3.1.5. The clarification meeting will be held. The date, time, and place of the meeting as mentioned in the Invitation for Pre-Qualification. The Applicant’s queries, if any, shall be sent to the Procuring Agency in writing at the following address:

Authorized person of the Applicants shall sign and stamp all pages of the application.

- 3.1.6. The Applicants understand that the scope of Works described is as under Para 2 above.

3.1.7. The Applicants shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of their applications and any other costs incurred in this regard.

3.1.8. The Procuring Agency reserves the rights for rejection of any application in case of non-compliance of the above requirements.

3.2. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

3.2.1. GENERAL

Pre-qualification will be based on all the criteria given in succeeding Paras 3.2.2, 3.2.3 and 3.3 regarding the Applicant's capabilities in financial, experience, personnel and equipment, as demonstrated by the Applicant's responses in the forms provided.

The Procuring Agency reserves the right to waive minor deviations if these don't materially affect the capability of an Applicant to perform the contract.

Sub-contractor's experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the Applicant's compliance with the qualifying criteria. However, for Joint Venture / Consortium, collective experience, resources and financial soundness of all partners shall be considered for the criteria given in Para 3.2.5.

Notwithstanding the Procuring Agency reserves the right to verify or seek clarification of the information furnished by the Applicants. The Procuring Agency may reject any application for any misrepresentation made by any Applicant in, or pursuant to, their application or for any statement furnished in connection therewith, and intended to be relied upon by the Procuring Agency, which is incorrect in any respect.

Eligibility and Qualification information described here below must be met by the legal entity(ies) comprising the Applicant, and not the Applicant's/JV partner's sister or parent companies, subsidiaries or affiliates.

3.2.2. MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

All the Applicants shall provide the following mandatory information/ documents:

(a) Registration with PEC:

- i. Local constructor(s) applying individually shall have valid registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in **Category C-A**; and at least in Specialization Codes **CE-01, CE-01(iii), CE-10, EE-04, EE-05 and EE-06**.
- ii. Local constructors may form Joint Venture/ Consortium:
 - With local partner, each partner must have valid registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in **Category C-A**.
 - with foreign constructor(s) having registration with Pakistan Engineering Council in **FC-A Category or above**

The Joint Venture/ Consortium collectively shall have at least Specialization Codes **CE-01, CE-01(iii), CE-10, EE-04, EE-05 and EE-06**.

- (b) Provision of valid NTN/STRN Certificate from Federal Board of Revenue to confirm status of being an active tax-payer.

- (c) Provision of following affidavits (on non-judicial stamp paper):
- An affidavit to the effect that the Applicant has never been black-listed by any previous Procuring Agency.
 - An affidavit to the effect that at-least one (01) number each Concrete Batching Plant and Concrete Paver along with allied equipment will be available in good working condition during mobilization for the execution of work.
 - An affidavit to the effect that all documents / particulars / information given with this application are true.
 - An affidavit to the effect that the Applicant has never indulged in corrupt, fraudulent or collusive practice for procuring contracts.
 - An affidavit to the effect that the Applicant is not presently involved nor has been in the past in litigation with its Procuring Agencies. Should this be otherwise the Applicant must provide such details in Form A-8 "Litigation/ Arbitration History".
- (d) Proof of not being on the list of debarred/ blacklisted firms and individuals on the websites of PEC and Federal & Provincial Procurement Regulatory Authorities and not having been declared debarred/ blacklisted by foreign country, international organizations or other foreign institutions.
- (e) Provision of verifiable audited financial statements of last three (03) years.
- (f) Provision of Joint Venture / Consortium Agreement in case of JV / Consortium.

The Applicants who do not meet any of the above mandatory requirements shall not be considered for detailed evaluation and shall be disqualified.

The applicants, having applied to PEC for any missing requisite PEC Codes but not yet granted by PEC, may participate on providing evidence of the same in the process but if declared technically qualified and subsequently Most Advantageous Bidder shall have to produce such granted Codes by PEC prior to entering into Contract Agreement.

3.2.3. DETAILED EVALUATION

After the initial screening of all the applications, a detailed evaluation shall be undertaken using the following criteria based on the scoring system as follows:

To qualify, Applicants must receive not less than the specified minimum acceptable **50 percent** marks for each category and aggregate of minimum **70** marks.

The Applicants are to provide substantial documentary evidence in each case for

marking in the Qualification Criteria. Where it is found that substantial evidence is not available, the marking will not be made.

3.3. CRITERIA FOR DETAILED EVALUATION

Detailed evaluation criteria are as below: -

3.3.1. Financial Capability

Financial Soundness of an Applicant will be considered as follows:

- i) The Applicant should demonstrate that he has access to, or has available liquid assets, un-encumbered real assets, lines of credit and other financial means sufficient to meet the cash flow for the execution of Works.
- ii) The Audited Financial Statements of last three (03) years (**Form A-2 and A-3**) from Chartered Accountant firm must be submitted and should demonstrate the soundness of the Applicant's financial position, showing long term profitability. Where necessary, the Procuring Agency may make inquiries with the Applicant's bankers, financial institutes and auditors.
- iii) Marks shall be awarded under this category based on the following criteria:

No marks shall be awarded to the constructor / JV members for financial capability less than specified limits.

3.3.2. Experience Capability

Experience for similar/ comparable projects completed (**Form A-4**) will be evaluated on the basis of the following marks. The similarity of the projects shall be based on pavement works. Please refrain from referring to the same project in multiple categories to ensure a comprehensive evaluation of your firm's capabilities across different domains. If a project is mentioned in different subcategories, marking will be assigned to only one of the subcategories.

No marks will be given if supporting documents are not submitted.

3.3.4. Equipment Capability (to be deployed at site during execution)

The Applicant should own, or have assured access to (through rental, lease, purchase agreement or other means), the following key equipment (limited to only major items of equipment) in full working order, and must demonstrate that, based on known commitments, these will be available for deployment on the proposed contract or works (**Form A-7**). The Applicant may also list alternative equipment which he would propose for the contract together with an explanation and documentary evidence of the alternate proposal. Marks will be given based on the following criteria:

No marks shall be awarded for equipment less than specified limits.

3.4. LITIGATION OR ARBITRATION/ DISPUTES HISTORY (Form A-8)

The Applicant shall provide accurate information of all litigation or arbitration/ disputes resulting from contracts completed or under execution over the last ten years (**Form A-8**). A consistent history of award against the Applicant or any partner of a Joint Venture / Consortium may result in rejection of the application.

Firms in litigation with the Procuring Agency shall not be permitted to participate in this process.

3.5. JOINT VENTURE (JV) / CONSORTIUM

Joint Venture (JV)/ Consortium must comply with the following requirements: -

3.5.1. Following are minimum qualification requirements:

- The lead partner shall meet not less than **55 percent** of all qualifying

criteria given in Paras 3.3 and 3.7 heretofore.

- ii) Each of the partners shall meet not less than **50 percent** of all the qualifying criteria given in Paras 3.3 and 3.7 heretofore.
- iii) The Joint Venture must collectively satisfy the criteria of Paras 3.3, and 3.7, for which purpose the relevant figures for each of the partners shall be added together to arrive at the JV's total capacity.

3.5.2. One of the Joint Venture / Consortium partners shall be nominated as being in charge/ lead partner; and this authorization shall be evidenced by submitting a power of attorney signed by legally authorized signatories of all the Joint Venture/ Consortium partners. The Joint Venture Agreement shall form the Integral Part of the Contract, if the Bid is accepted by the Procuring Agency. The Joint Venture Agreement shall bound all parties to execute the Works as per their participating interests and the Joint Venture Agreement must clearly indicate Share (%) in J.V and division of works/ responsibilities between the J.V. partners.

3.5.3. Application shall be signed by all members in the JV/ Consortium, so as to legally bind all partners, jointly and severally. The application shall be submitted along with a copy of the JV/ Consortium agreement providing the joint and several liabilities with respect to the contract.

3.5.4. The pre-qualification of a Joint Venture (JV)/ Consortium does not necessarily qualify any of its partners individually or as a partner in any other Joint Venture (JV)/ Consortium. In case of dissolution of a Joint Venture (JV)/ Consortium, each one of the constituent firms may qualify if they meet all the pre-qualification requirements and any partner has requested/shall request for the same and then his pre-qualification shall be subject to the written approval of the Procuring Agency.

3.5.5. Constructor(s) / firm(s) in JV shall submit details of distribution of works to be executed by the foreign / local partners of JV with specific reference to works, equipment, resources and responsibilities along with JV Agreement.

3.6. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The Applicant (including all members of a Joint Venture (JV)/ Consortium must not be associated, nor have been associated in the past, with the consultant or any other entity that has prepared the design, specifications, and other pre-qualification and bidding documents for the project, or was proposed as Engineer for the contract, over the last five years. Any such association may result in disqualification of the Applicant.

3.7. UPDATING PRE-QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

Bidders shall be required to update the financial, personnel and equipment information used for pre-qualification at the time of submitting their bids, to confirm their continued compliance with the Qualification Criteria and verification of the information provided at the time of pre-qualification. A bid shall be rejected if the Applicant's qualification thresholds are no longer met at the time of bidding.

3.8. OTHER FACTORS

3.8.1. Only firms and JVs/ Consortia that have been pre-qualified under this procedure shall be invited to bid. A qualified firm or a member of a qualified JV may participate only in one bid for the contract. If a firm submits more than one bid, singly or as a JV, all bids including that bidder will be rejected. This rule

will not apply in respect of bids which include specialist subcontractors who are used by more than one bidder.

3.8.2. The Procuring Agency reserves the right to: -

- a) Amend the scope and value of any contract(s) to be bid, in which event the bidder(s) will only bid among those pre-qualified bidders who meet the requirements of the contract(s) as amended. However, the Procuring Agency has to review the disqualified bids who originally do not meet the specified criteria for Pre-qualification.
- b) Reject or accept any application; and
- c) Cancel the pre-qualification process and reject all applications.

The Procuring Agency shall neither be liable for any such actions nor be under any obligation to inform the Applicant of the grounds for rejection, however, may be debriefed if solicited.

3.8.3. Applicants will be informed in writing or email of the results of their applications and may be debriefed if solicited.
