1. Sealed Tenders / Quotations are invited for upcoming HMT Contract 2026-29, from reputable, well-experienced (minimum 5 years general experience in heavy transport fleet management), financially-sound and Income Tax-registered Mechanical Transport Contractors for transportation of Aviation fuel from Attock Oil Refinery Limited, Rawalpindi to all Bases / Units of Pakistan Air Force.

2. Interested parties, owning fleet of large - sized tankers, with capacity 40,000 - 56,000 and small - sized tankers, with capacity 12,000 - 24,000 liters and prepared on **OGRA STANDARDS (S.R.O. 900(I)2009, dated 20 October, 2009 and PAF Quality Standards)**, equipped with the latest products handling / safety equipment and preferably, satellite-based Tracker System, meeting quality safety standards and having requisite management experience to provide safe, timely and high-quality service, may participate in bidding by providing competitive rates, along with the undermentioned information:-

- (a) Owners / Partners Name, address, telephone, mobile numbers and fax number of the company.
- (b) Profile of the company, management and key personnel. Status of the firm; whether proprietorship / partnership / public or private limited company.
- (c) Attested copy of CNIC of owner / partners / key operating personnel of the company are to be attached with the application.
- (d) Work experience with major organizations, along with detail of agreements / contracts.
- (e) Details of vehicles owned, along with registration number, model, make, year of purchase, loading capacity, number of compartments, etc.
- (f) Details of product-handling, quality certification / safety equipment, fire extinguishers, coupling and earthing system, installed on these vehicles.
- (g) Detail of HR Management system, along with complete organization structure.
- (h) Details of satellite-based Tracker system, installed on these vehicles.
- (j) Financial status duly verified / Name of bankers and certificate of financial stability.
- (k) Sales Tax and Income Tax registration certificate, details of Income Tax Returns and copy of assessment / payment of Income Tax.
- (l) Detail of ISO Certificates (if any).
- (m) Detail of transport HSE system for fleet management.
- (n) Detail of drivers training courses, along with salaries and incentives.
- (p) Detail of workshop and Base station at Rawalpindi or other locations.
- (q) Detail of legal affairs (if any).

Firms interested to participate can collect **Tender Forms** and supporting documents / guidelines / information, from the undermentioned office, during working hours **(0800 hrs to 1400 hrs)** and submit the Tender forms, complete-in-all respect by **26 February, 2026** by 1200 hrs. Receipts, of Tender forms / documents will be entertained after specific time. The Tender will be opened on **26 February, 2026, 1230 hrs**.

The offer will consist of two separate quotations, as follows:-

a. **Technical Quotation:** It should contain all relevant information on **Technical Quotation Form**, available in IT documents, duly filled in and enclosed with details of bowzers available for subject Contract.

b. **Commercial Quotation:** The quotation will be in single, and will indicate your offered rates (Figures, as well as, words) for delivery of Aviation Fuel to each PAF Base, mentioned on PAF Z-2121 (Commercial Quotation).

It should clearly be marked, in fact, on the envelopes **"Technical Quotation"** and **"Commercial Quotation"**, Both the envelopes of commercial and technical offers should be enclosed in one cover, properly sealed, bearing the address of this office, without any indication that there is a Tender within.

Commercial quotations of only those firms will be opened, whose technical quotations are accepted by technical authorities. Commercial quotations of technically-rejected firms will be returned to the firms unopened.

### Note:-

1. Pre-qualified and Registered Firms will be given preference.
2. If information provided found incorrect, at any stage, your request for participating in tender will be cancelled.
3. Tender winning firms will be responsible to offer HMTs for inspection within in 10 days after tender opening. After that, requisite work will be executed, as per PAF quality policy. Firm owner is to furnish affidavit regarding correctness of technical offer. If firm fails to offer HMTs for commissioning, its technical offer will be rejected.
