02. Following the pre-bid meeting, held on 1st June 2026, and feedback received from prospective bidders, the Procuring Agency has reviewed the BOQ and technical requirements. In order to ensure fair competition, accurate pricing, and submission of responsive bids, certain amendments are being issued in the bidding document.

03. The Procuring Agency has determined that certain BOQ items require further clarification and rationalization to enable bidders to accurately assess the scope of work and submit competitive bids.

04. Therefore, bidders are advised to conduct a detailed site survey prior to submission of the bids. Submission of a bid shall be deemed confirmation that the bidder has satisfied itself regarding site conditions and scope of work.

05. Furthermore, Complete supply, installation, testing and commissioning of cabling required for the system as per specifications and site conditions – Lump Sum.

06. In view of the amendments issued through this corrigendum and to provide adequate time to prospective bidders for preparation of responsive bids, the bid submission date is extended from 03rd June 2026 to 15th June 2026.

2. The interested firms should submit in the Technical Envelop duly stamped Signed having the name of the firm, address(s), signature of representative, valid enlistment / renewal of firm with PEC (having relevant category and codes), tax registrations & Completion certificate of similar nature of work done during last 5 years. The details of the submissions are given in the bidding document.
3. The owner of the firm should submit the application and collect the tender by himself. In case of authorized person, authority letter (regarding the particular work) in favor of the person deputed on the letter pad of the firm is required along-with copy of CNIC. This shall be uploaded in the technical envelop. Details of submission are available in the bidding document. If any contractor wants to participate in tender opening process through their representative, they should issue authority letter on letter head pad of the firm depicting complete valid address & contact numbers along with attested copy of CNIC this shall be presented at the time of opening of the bid.
4. The Bid Security shall be in the form of Call Deposit bearing Name of Firm in favor of Assistant Collector, (HQ), Collector of Custom (Enforcement), Peshawar from local scheduled Bank of Pakistan in the technical envelop. Without call deposit the firms shall be rejected in the technical evaluation stage. Cash /cheque will not be accepted.
5. The contractor will submit the documentary evidence as per instructions in the bidding documents, without which tender will be liable for rejection.
6. A Pay Order amounting to PKR 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), issued in favor of Assistant Collector (HQ), Collector of Customs (Enforcement), Peshawar, from any scheduled bank operating in Pakistan.

3. Quotation documents are available in Customs House, University Road Peshawar. Interested firms / companies are requested to collect Quotation documents from the Customs House dated **18th June 2026**.
4. Bids complete in all respect should reach the office of the undersigned up to **18th June 2026 till 10:30am hours** and technical Bids will be opened at 11:00am hours on same day in the conference hall of Customs House Peshawar.
5. The Collectorate of Customs Enforcement reserves the right to accept or reject at any time prior to the acceptance of any or all the tenders / bids.
6. Bidders shall submit separate technical and financial bids for each individual site.
7. The work should be completed **within ____ Months from signing** of Contract Agreement.
8. Joint Venture (JV) and Subcontracting of any sort is not allowed.
9. An abnormally low bid will be rejected. Moreover, The bidders are to submit market analysis report along with the their quotation
