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1. Introduction

The Government of Pakistan has received a tied loan of USD 158.416 Million from the Economic Development Cooperation Fund (EDCF) of the Republic of Korea, administered by the Export-Import Bank of Korea (KEXIM Bank), for the Establishment of IT Park Project in Karachi. As per detail design, the project involves construction of an 8-storey building (plus 3 basements, gross floor area $\approx 111,605 \text{ m}^2$) including offices, data centers (Tier-III rated), amenities, backup power, parking, and full ICT infrastructure & security systems, plus local training. The project site is located at CAA Colony, Faisal Cantonment, near Jinnah International airport Karachi.

The design consultant (Junglim JV, Korea) has completed detailed design and project documents as per the consultancy agreement. The project is currently ready for procurement stage. Bidding is restricted to Korean-nationality entities (or JV/Consortium including at least one Korean construction firm and one Korean ICT firm), in line with EDCF tied-loan requirements and the Guidelines for Procurement under EDCF.

This EOI Document is designed for shortlisting of the consultancy firms for further participation of such shortlisted consultancy firms in the procurement process and subsequently to procure consultancy firms to carry-out services to review and vet the entire Project Documents and supporting documents (as specified in the TORs) before advertising for Hiring of Korean Contractor.

This EOI document is harmonized with the guidelines of Public Procurement Rules and relevant EOI documents for consultants of Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC).

2. Instructions for EOI

- Quality & Cost-Based Selection procedure will be followed. The electronic EOI document, containing detailed requirements, terms and conditions is also available on e-Pak Acquisition and Disposal System (EPADS) at (<https://eprocure.gov.pk>) website.
- The electronic EOI shall only be submitted through EPADS not later than **June 23rd, 2026 at 1500 hours PST**. Manual EOIs shall not be accepted. The electronic EOI shall be opened on the same day through EPADS by **1530 hours PST**.
- For registration and training on EPADS or in case of any technical difficulty in using EPADS, prospective bidders may contact PPRA Team, Director MIS Room No.109, 1st Floor, FBC building Sector G-5/2, Islamabad. Contact Number 051-111-137-237.
- Only those proposals will be entertained who applied through EPADS <https://eprocure.gov.pk>
- In terms of the Rule 48 of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 Grievance Redressal Committee (GRC) has been constituted for subject consultancy. GRC is provided on EPADS at (<https://eprocure.gov.pk>).
- The organization should possess proven qualification for technical expertise as well as financial competence in the domain. Details of the qualification and experience should be provided in the EOI.
- The organization will state the key considerations, envisaged scope of work, development methodology and deliverables in its proposal against EOI for the following objectives and scope, and any additional warranted objectives and terms that may be envisaged significant for

effective dispensation of the consultancy.

- The organization will be short-listed based on the ‘Evaluation Criteria’ as mentioned in section 5. The EOI should accordingly provide relevant information in sufficient detail covering the aspects mentioned therein to aid evaluation.

- The Request for Proposals (RFP) will only be shared with the short-listed organizations at subsequent stage.

3. Objectives of the Assignment

The EoI is aimed at identifying a firm capable of following:

- To ensure that the complete Bidding Documents, RFP, and draft Contract fully comply with the approved PC-1, EDCF/EXIM Bank Rules & Procurement Guidelines, and applicable Pakistani laws.
- To ensure the bidding documents and its supporting data provide comprehensive risk allocation that safeguards the rights and interests of PSEB/MoITT, and shield PSEB/MoITT from unjustified claims and minimizes exposure to disputes during execution.
- To provide robust, enforceable mechanisms (e.g., Clause 8.7 Delay Damages) to ensure timely completion within the tied Korean procurement environment.

4. Scope of Work

The selected firm shall perform a comprehensive, clause-by-clause review of the RFP, draft contract, detail design and all associated documents, BOQs and all associated documents, technical specifications and all associated documents, Engineer’s Estimates and all associated documents, Unit Rates Analysis with complete supporting documents as well as any other documents forming part of the complete Project Documents package.

The detailed design, BOQs, specifications and cost estimates of project include Architecture, Structural, Electrical, Plumbing, Fire Fighting, HVAC, ICT & Data Center, Vertical Transportation System, Building Management System Design, Land Landscape, Building Maintenance Unit, Access Control & Security System, Traffic Entrance & Exit, Parking System, Furniture and Fixtures etc.

4.1. Detailed Review of Documents

1. Verify full alignment with the approved PC-1 and feasibility study (scope, cost, timelines, benefits).
2. Confirm scope and consistency with the Junglim JV Consultancy Agreement and the RFP with EDCF procurement guidelines (main contractor and sub-contractor’s selections, The Engineer and its representative’s selection, eligibility of contractor, evaluation criteria for contractor, etc.)
3. Review of the detailed design and its compliance with the approved scope of PC-1/feasibility study, the bylaws of the local authority. Review of all associated external services in design for the functionality of the project immediately after TOC.

4. Assess whether all provisions (eligibility, qualification, bid security, performance security, payment terms, advance payments, variations, price adjustment formula with calculations for weightages, claims, disputes, termination, insurance, Force Majeure, intellectual property, confidentiality, recoveries etc.) adequately protect the Employer's interests, minimize risks, and provide clear, enforceable remedies.
5. Identify ambiguities, gaps, inconsistencies, or provisions that could favor the Contractor or expose the Employer to disproportionate risk. Check the documents authenticity submitted by design consultant.
6. The selected firm shall review the BOQs along with quantity take-off sheets, confirm quantities are against the design documents, the Engineer's Estimate, Unit rates, Rate Analysis with its complete supporting documents (including the basis of its preparation and its consistency with local & international standards, up-to-date market, detailed drawings and specifications) to identify feasible cost-saving measures, where applicable, review detailed cost assessment prepared by design consultant and shall submit appropriate recommendations to the Employer, if any.
7. The selected firm shall critically examine the detailed specifications of all BOQ & design items to ensure that they are prepared in accordance with local and international standards and that all information is complete for the execution of the work and its payments. The selected firm shall also ensure that the requirements for the submission of submittals are clear, and that the selected materials, specified brands, and approved brand lists are appropriate, competitive, and fully aligned with the project specifications and latest industry standards and requirements.
8. Recommend specific missing and incomplete data (with tracked changes/red-line version) to strengthen Employer protections while remaining compliant with EDCF rules and not unduly deterring competitive bidding from qualified Korean firms.
9. The selected firm shall review all relevant documents prepared by design consultant to ensure accuracy and completeness, and conduct on-site inspections where necessary. The selected firm shall confirm that all information is correct and report any discrepancies identified.
10. Critically examine Clause 8.7 PCC (0.03% of final Contract Price per day of delay for the Works and for predefined major milestones/sections, capped at 10%). evaluate its practicality and enforceability under Pakistani law and FIDIC principles.
11. Assess whether the current rate and cap are sufficient to incentivize timely progress and protect the Employer against economic/operational losses from delays in this high-value, time-sensitive IT Park project (including data-center commissioning and operational readiness).
12. Advise explicitly on whether the proposed delay damages mechanism alone is adequate, or whether an additional penalty clause (or enhanced milestone-specific mechanism) is required to keep the Contractor on track.
13. If the selected firm recommends an additional clause, provide a draft penalty / enhanced liquidated damages clause fully aligned with standard FIDIC provisions in EDCF procurement guideline, clearly distinguishing it from punitive penalties, including appropriate caps, triggers linked to major milestones/sections, and integration language for the Particular Conditions.

4.2. Other Critical Review of RFP

1. Qualification and evaluation criteria (financial, experience, personnel, equipment, credit rating).

2. Payment terms, advance payment, retention, price adjustment formula and its detailed calculations, and currency provisions, all type of taxation and payments mechanism to contractors with its cost assessment prepared by design consultant.
3. ICT-specific requirements (Tier-III Data Center, security systems, training, O&M during DLP).
4. Risk allocation (Employer's Risks, Contractor's Care of Works, insurance deductibles etc).
5. Dispute resolution methods and post termination balance work execution for completion of project.

5. Criteria for selection of consultancy firms

5.1. Mandatory Eligibility Criteria

This Invitation for Shortlisting of Consultancy firms is open to all consultancy firms meeting with the following mandatory requirements. Please provide photocopies of requisite documents.

- Duly licensed/registered by the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) & Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners (PCATP).
- Proposed Engineers shall be member(s) of PEC.
- The Proposed Architect shall be a member of PCATP
- Enlisted by the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR)/ relevant provincial department as active taxpayer.
- Undertaking on stamp paper of Rs.100 that firm is not blacklisted by any Provisional or Federal Government Department, Agency, Organization or autonomous body or any private sector organization in Pakistan.
- Consultancy Firms, not fulfilling the aforesaid mandatory requirements for eligibility, shall not be considered for further evaluation.

5.2 Joint Venture (JV) / Consortium Evaluation Criteria

Applicants may participate either as a single entity or as a Joint Venture (JV)/Consortium. In the case of a JV/Consortium:

- A Lead Partner shall be nominated through a duly executed JV/Consortium Agreement and shall be authorized to represent all members during the procurement process.
- All members of the JV/Consortium shall be jointly and severally liable for the performance of the contract, if awarded.
- Mandatory technical and professional qualifications, including registrations with the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC) and the Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners (PCATP), relevant experience, personnel, and similar requirements, shall be assessed collectively.
- Eligibility and mandatory requirements of tax registration and non-blacklisting declarations, shall be fulfilled individually by each member of the JV/Consortium. Professional registrations and licenses shall be evaluated in accordance with the scope of work assigned to each JV member.

- A Joint Venture member providing engineering services shall possess a valid registration/license with the Pakistan Engineering Council (PEC), while a JV member providing architectural or planning services shall possess a valid registration/license with the Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners (PCATP). Collectively, the JV/Consortium shall possess all professional registrations and licenses required for the successful execution of the assignment.
- Technical qualifications, relevant experience, financial capacity, key personnel, and other qualification requirements shall be evaluated collectively by aggregating the credentials and resources of all JV/Consortium members.
- No member of a JV/Consortium may participate in more than one application, either individually or as a member of another JV/Consortium, in the same procurement process.

6. Additional Considerations

6.1. Compliance and Ethics

- Commitment to ethical research practices, data privacy, and compliance with local and international regulations.
- No record of blacklisting or poor performance in previous assignments.

6.2. Financial and Operational Stability

- Demonstrated financial stability and operational capacity to deliver the assignment within the stipulated timeframe.
- Submission of audited financial statements for the last three years.

7. Submission Requirements

Applicants must submit the following as part of their Expression of Interest (EOI):

- Company Profile with details of address of consultancy office(s).
- Consultancy Registration/ License from PEC and Registration with PCATP for current year and copies of registration from PEC/PCATP of nominated design engineers, architects etc.
- NTN Registration No. and Sales Tax Registration No.
- Organization Chart of Consultancy firm, detailing enough for Lead Positions, Senior Positions and Junior Positions.
- Details of International Affiliations.
- Details of in-hand Projects with client's details and their status with approximate fee of design and supervision services.
- Last 3 years financial statements.

8. Evaluation Process

All EOIs will be evaluated based on the above criteria. Only those meeting the mandatory eligibility requirements and scoring highest on technical and organizational capacity will be shortlisted for further

consideration.

The minimum threshold marks for the qualification of consultancy firms in the shortlisting process shall be 70% of the total points.

8.1. The evaluation criteria weightage for shortlisting of consultancy firms shall be as under:

- i. Experience of Consultancy Firm: 30% of Total Points.
- ii. Quality of Consultancy firm's Personal (staff) Expertise: 70% of Total Points.

8.2. Evaluation of Experience of Consultancy Firms (30%):

The Experience of Consultancy firms (30% of Total Points) further categorized into following three heads:

- Weightage of Specific Projects Experience: 70%
- Weightage of General Projects Experience: 25%
- Weightage of Local Office in Islamabad/ Rawalpindi: 05%

8.2.1. Evaluation for Specific Experience (70%):

The evaluation of specific experience is based on similar projects in magnitude and complexity, for the purpose of ranking of the firms for inclusion in the shortlisting. The five (05) number of similar projects within last 10 years, shall carry 100% marks in specific experience and the distribution of marks is as under.

- Detailed Construction Supervision – 10%

8.2.2. Evaluation for General Experience (25%):

The evaluation of general experience is based on general projects undertaken by consultancy firms. The five (05) number of general projects within last 10 years, shall contribute 100% marks in general experience. The distribution of marks is as under.

8.2.3. Evaluation for Local Office of Consultancy firms for Design Services (05%):

If the office is located in Islamabad/ Rawalpindi for Consultancy Services then 05% marks shall be provided as per categorization stipulated in form C-1 at ANNEX-C, otherwise no

marks shall be provided under this category.

8.3. Evaluation of Quality of Consultancy firms Personals (Staff): (70%)

The Experience of Personnels/Staff (70% of Total Points) further categorized into following two heads:

- Weightage of Academic & General Qualifications: 30%
- Weightage of Professional Experience of Nominated Staff: 70%

The Consultancy firm's personals (staff) will be evaluated on the basis of the following two items of qualification as demonstrated in their CVs:

8.3.1. Academic & General Qualification – 30%

- Basic Qualification/ Degree (Specified Disciplines) – 80%
- Masters/ Post Graduate (Specified Disciplines) – 20%

8.3.2. Detailed Evaluation Mechanism:

8.4. Detailed Evaluation Mechanism:

- If any resource/discipline/nominated staff is working at Lead Position on similar and/ or general projects then complete marks for Senior & Junior Position will be awarded in respective experience.

- If any resource/discipline/nominated staff is working at Senior Position on similar and/ or general projects then complete marks for Junior Position will be awarded in respective experience.
- If any discipline has worked more than 1 similar Projects then complete marks against General experience shall be awarded.

9. Finalization of Shortlisting of Consultancy firms:

- The consulting Firm shall be evaluated by Selection Committee, appointed by the PSEB, in accordance with their submitted shortlisting applications as per eligibility requirements and evaluation criteria thereon.
- The committee having right for solicitation of clarifications regarding submitted details/ documents/requirements from the consultancy firms.
- The selection committee appointed by PSEB, will prepare a comparative statement of marks obtained by the competing consulting firm.
- The evaluation report of Shortlisting Process of Consultancy firms shall be placed on PSEB's website and EPADS/ PPRA Website.
- The applicants securing 70 or above marks shall be considered as shortlisted Consultancy firms.
- The shortlisted consultancy firms shall only be eligible for further procurement process and invited to submit technical and financial proposals solicited through RFP (Request for Proposal) by Pakistan Software Export Board.
