### **HOW TO APPLY**

The proposals shall be opened on the same day at **1430 hours** in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives.

Pre-bid meetings shall be held on **8<sup>th</sup> July, 2026 (Monday) at 1100 hours** at the respective project offices. In case of any unforeseen circumstances, bids shall be opened on the next working day at the same time and venue. No queries shall be entertained at the time of bid opening. **Interested firms may submit proposals for one or more projects. Separate Technical and Financial Proposals shall be submitted for each project.**
